Definitions of the 8 values of the Korean sword

- 1. Filial Piety: Dutiful respect or regard for parents, race, etc.
- 2. Loyalty: Faithful in allegiance to one's country and government; faithful to a person, cause, idea, or custom.
- 3. Benevolence: The inclination to be charitable.
- 4. Brave: Having or displaying courage; n. An American Indian warrior.
- 5. Faith: A belief in the value, truth, or trustworthiness of someone or something; belief and trust in God, the scriptures or other religious writings; a system of religious beliefs.
- 6. Wisdom: The ability to understand what is right, true, or enduring; good judgement; knowledge.
- 7. Chivalry: The noble qualities of a knight, such as courage, honor, and a readiness to help the weak and protect women. The demonstration of any of the knightly qualities.
- 8. Righteousness: To act in a just, upright manner; doing what is right; virtuous.
